Ways Parents Can Help

We respect the right of privacy for the children. Please be aware of this when you are helping in the classroom. Children are sometimes the source of much information outside the classroom. Please also keep private your observations of the children in the classroom setting. If you have any concerns please direct those to the teacher or director. We will be glad to discuss these with you.

Communication

We will do our best to keep communication open with our parents. We will send home weekly newsletters and other information that pertains to our classroom activities. Parents may contact the teachers at any time if needed. However please do not use classroom time to discuss lengthy issues. If you ever have any questions or concerns please let us know.

Parent/Teacher Conferences

We will hold parent conferences twice a year for all classes. We will schedule one in Dec and the second in May. This is a time to learn about your child's daily activities, and how they are progressing. This is also a good time to ask questions and voice concerns you may have.
